**👉 Now insert the UmiKey into the USB port of your PC**

For Windows Users	For Linux Users	For Mac Users
1) The 1 <sup>st</sup> time you need to wait for a few seconds and see the message: <b>New Device Found! Ready to Use.</b> 2) Auto-navigation should kick in	1) Hold the button down when inserting Umikey to USB 2) Auto-navigation should kick in	1) Mac treats UmiKey as a keyboard and may prompt you to install a keyboard. Ignore the message and press <b>'Continue'</b> to move on.  2) In the "Select keyboard type" dialog. Select <b>ANSI</b> and press done.

If auto-navigation does not kick in, unplug and insert again or point your browser to: <http://umikey.com/a> and press the UmiKey button to generate the KeyID + OTP.

### ? How to Use the UmiKey Button?



1. When the light shines steadily
2. Press the button gently
3. After 1 second, the light ring goes off, output goes to your PC, then release your finger

### ? First-time Q&A

- **UmiKey insertion/removal feels tight in the USB port, is that normal?**  
**Ans.** It is because on the sides of the USB head, there are rails keeping the UmiKey steady in the USB port to make sure it doesn't get loose.
